



2024 Richard D. Morse Memorial Award

The Adirondack Research Consortium is delighted to present the 2024 Richard D. Morse Memorial Award. This **annual \$500 award** is given to a student from a college/university in the region who shares Rick's enthusiasm for environmental policy, music, and outdoor activities. The money is used to finance research or educational activities.

To be considered for eligibility, students must be in good standing, enrolled in a program related to environmental science, and have interests in music and outdoor activities. Faculty representatives may submit nominations for students with a short statement detailing their qualifications by **May 1st, 2024**.

The Award will be made directly to the student and presented at the Awards Luncheon during the 28th Annual Conference on the Adirondacks on **May 17th, 2024**, at the High Peaks Resort in Lake Placid. This is a one-time award, with applications for future awards welcome. We expect to continue this annual award until the funds have been fully utilized.
